



In October 2018, the Pennsylvania School Code was amended to include a section on Sun Protection Measures for Students. Section 1414.10 states that “a school entity shall allow” the application of sunscreen “during school hours, at a school-sponsored activity, or while under the supervision of school personnel.” The full legislation is available for review on the Pennsylvania General Assembly’s website.

Parents/guardians are asked to apply sunscreen to their child(ren) before drop-off in the morning. They may also choose to supply their child(ren) with **non-aerosol, topical sunscreen**, approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration, to be reapplied as necessary during school or camp hours, at school-sponsored activities, or while under the supervision of school personnel. Sunscreen must be labelled with the child’s full name.

By signing below, you acknowledge that:

- You and/or your child know(s) the proper method of applying the provided sunscreen.
- Any specific instructions for applying the sunscreen will be communicated to The Grayson School staff. If necessary, an authorized staff member will help your child apply sunscreen.
- You know the proper safety precautions for handling and disposing of the sunscreen.

The Grayson School may restrict the use of the provided sunscreen if the student fails to comply with rules concerning its proper application.
