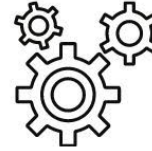


# DIRECT YOUR TAX DOLLARS TO THE GRAYSON SCHOOL

THE PA EITC PROGRAM EXPLAINED  
(EDUCATIONAL IMPROVEMENT TAX CREDIT PROGRAM)

## WHAT IS EITC?

A state program that allows you to direct your PA tax dollars to Grayson for financial aid scholarships. If you participate for two consecutive years, you receive a tax credit equal to 90% of your contribution.



## THE IMPORTANCE OF SCHOLARSHIPS

These funds make it possible for gifted students who would otherwise be unable to afford a private school education to gain the full benefits of the education they deserve, and aid in building an extraordinary community at Grayson. In 2019-2020, PA tax dollars, directed to Grayson through the EITC program covered 70% of our financial aid scholarships.



## BUT THIS SOUNDS TOO GOOD TO BE TRUE. . .

We often hear this! But the goal of the EITC program is to help individuals/companies support and promote the educational interests of the children of Pennsylvania. In fact, the PA state government has continued to increase the amount EITC dollars available every year.



## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Individuals/couples and/or businesses with a minimum PA tax liability of at least \$3500 annually are eligible to participate in this program.



## HOW TO APPLY
